SUNDAY, APRIL 26, 2015 at 11am

A **brunch gathering** is planned at the historic BOURSE Building on 5th Street between Market and Ranstead Streets. There is a food court in the atrium of the building with lots of seating and a variety of food options: Bains Deli, Coffee kiosk, Smoothie Shop, bakery, etc. Pay your own way. It is a perfect meeting spot to gather before going to the nearby museums or to continue being with classmates.

SUNDAY, APRIL 26, 2015 afternoon

We have arranged for a **docent-led museum tour** of either the African American Museum of Philadelphia or the National Museum of American Jewish History. After the tour, you may spend as much time as you like exploring the museum.

African American Museum of Philadelphia at 7th and Arch Streets. Starting at **2pm**, a 60 minute docent-led tour will explore the core features and little known facts of the African American Diaspora.

OR

National Museum of American Jewish History, 5th and Market Streets. Starting at **1pm**, a 90 minute docent-led private tour will present the core exhibit features of American Jewish history from 1654 to the present.
